

**Extreme Physiology Intersession Course
Costs, Payment Deadlines, Refund Schedule and Included Expenses**

Course Costs

Extreme Physiology Travel Course Fee: approximately, \$2625 – based on expectation of 10-student enrollment. Final Course fee will be determined and published prior to the end of the full-refund deadline.

Tuition: \$1132 – this represents a discount to 1/3 of the normal intersession tuition of \$1132 per credit. Extreme Physiology is a 3-credit course.

Round-trip Airfare to Tucson, AZ - airfare is not included in the Course Fee or tuition. Each student is responsible for booking his/her own flight, with an arrival date of January 1, 2017 and a departure date of January 25, 2017. Round-trip coach airfare is currently running \$425-600. Students may also be responsible for airport shuttle fees from Tucson Intl. Airport to the on-location course residence (an approximately 20 mile trip), but we will attempt to accommodate pickup from and delivery to the airport, if possible.

Payment Deadlines

Thursday, October 4, 2018 (\$400 deposit with course application)

Thursday, October 25, 2018 (\$875 2nd deposit)

Thursday, November 8, 2018 (Full Payment, balance of \$1350)

Refund Schedule

Until October 26, 2018, all monies (deposit and balance) paid for the trip will be fully refunded to any student withdrawing his/her registration and to any student who was not accepted into the course.

Beginning October 26, 2018, the 1st and 2nd deposits (totaling \$1275) are non-refundable unless the student withdrawing registration can be replaced by another student accepted into the course by the course instructor. Between October 26 and November 8, 2018, any monies paid beyond the 1st and 2nd deposits toward the Full Course Payment will be refunded to a student withdrawing registration.

After November 8, 2018, we cannot guarantee refund of any committed monies, but will make every effort to recover and refund the most money that we can.

Tuition recovery insurance is available from third parties. Students who are interested in such insurance should inquire about it through the Dean's Office of the College of Arts and Sciences.
